March for Life 2017 Diocese of Bismarck Pilgrimage Q&A:

Who is it for?

9th-12th graders from parish groups or individual families

How to get there?

On a charter bus! We will drive through the night to get there, and through the night on the return home, to maximize our time (all day Thurs-Fri-Sat) in DC.

When?

Tuesday evening, January 24th (load up at 7:00pm) through Sunday evening January 29th (into Bismarck around 10:30pm). Teens will only miss 3 days of school.

Is this the same as the Catholic high school groups?

This trip is a welcome parallel, but separate trip, from the Catholic high school trips which are filling up so quickly that those who don't attend the schools need an alternative. What a blessing that we have this need!

Cost?

The cost per teen for this 6-day, 5-night trip is \$550, and is all-inclusive of meals, tickets, and accommodations. Fundraising is encouraged, and ideas are posted to the website.

How many?

We are able to take up to 40 youth on a first-come, first-serve basis (and waiting list) system.

How to register?

Registration can be done through the website, and the \$75 deposit can be paid through the website as well. The balance will be due December 5th by the start of our pre-March meeting for parents, chaperones, and teens. Permission slips will also be due at that time, and are available for download on the website.

Learn to "Stop" Inappropriate Activity Before It Happens

Child safety tip: Teach your child to respect the word "stop!" Teach your preschooler that "stop" means "stop," and that your child has the right to stop people from touching his or her body. Obviously, exceptions will have to be made for doctors and parents, but even parents must listen when a child doesn't want to be tickled or hugged anymore. Reinforcing this excellent lesson gives your child the power to recognize—and to stop— "bad touching" by others if it should happen.—Diocese of Bismarck.
