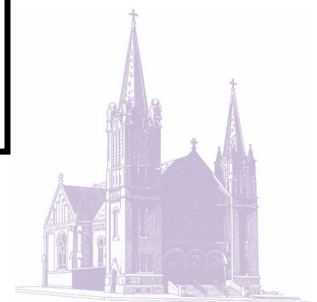

Easter Baskets

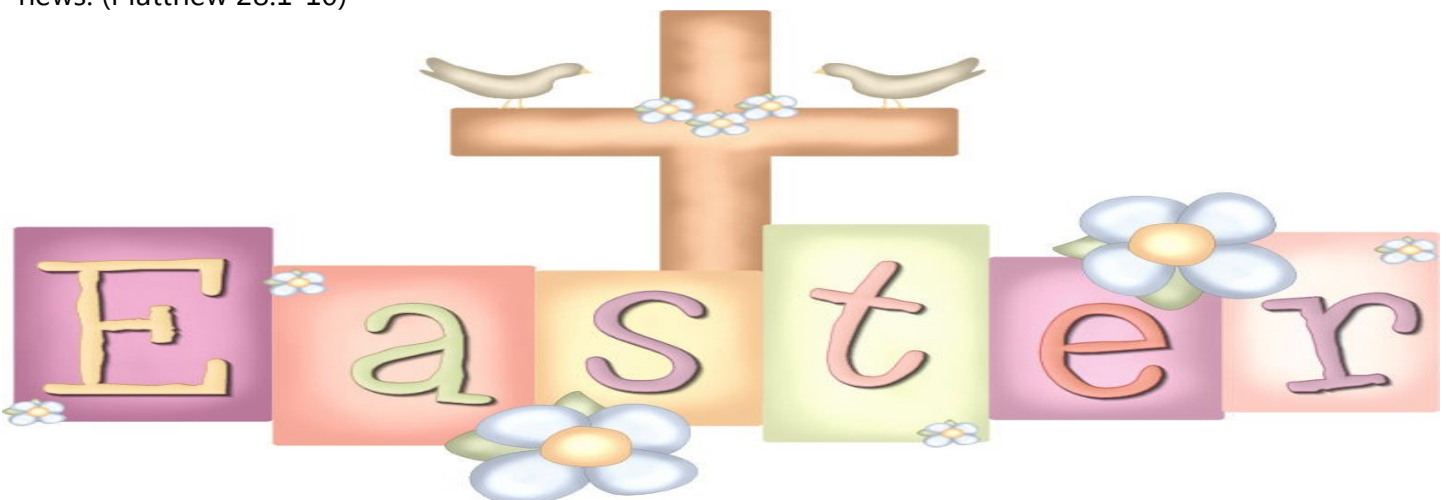
The Holy Name Men will be giving Easter baskets to all the children after all Easter Sunday Masses. Stop down to the church basement to receive one.
